- “8 – 501 Fence Fence including ornamental hedges on sites situated at intersection of streets mused by vehicular traffic, that are within a distance of 30 feet (9.144m) from the point of intersection of the alignments of those streets shall not be constructed to a greater height than 1.200 metres above the level of the footpath except with the consent of the Board.
“8 – 504 Barbed Wire Where barbed wire is erected adjacent to a street it shall be set back not less than 6 inches from the street alignment up to a height of 7 feet 6 inches (2.288m) above the level of the street and in no case shall barbed-wire protect beyond the street alignments.
